Hindu Progressed Horoscope

Introduction

THERE are three popular schools of thought in Hindu predictive astrology. These can broadly be classified as the ones that follow (1) Sage Parasara (2) Maharshi Jaimini and (3) Tajaka System expounded by savants like Nilakantha and Keshava. The system in vogue in our country today can mainly be attributed to the writings of our Rishis and ably expounded by later writers like Varahamihira, Kalyana Varma, Mantreswara and Venkatesa through

their respective works Brihat Jataka, Saravali, Phaladeepika and Sarvartha Chintamani.

The Annual or Progressed Horoscope or the Varshaphal comes under the Tajaka school. In interpreting it, a point of contact is established between the birth Lagna or Ascendant and a mathematical point known as Muntha. Muntha is supposed to travel at the rate of one Rasi per year from the natal Ascendant. Once the position of Muntha is determined, the following results can be indicated based on where Muntha falls (Table I).

Table 1: Results of Muntha in Different Houses

Muntha in House	Effects
and their	Destruction of enemies, honour, birth of issue, gain of vehicle, vitality, elevation in one's job and access to fresh sources of income.
2	Fame, honour and happiness.
3	Success over enemies, happiness from friends and relatives, good health, support of people well placed in life.
4	Mental affliction, sickness, misunderstanding with kith and kin.
5	Wisdom, religious learning, birth of children, pilgrimage.
6	Increase in debts, diseases, fear of thieves, increase of enemies.
7	Sorrow to wife, quarrels, failure, disappointment, loss of money.
8	Fear of thieves and enemies, illness, wastage of money on unworthy causes.
9	Favors from superiors, access to wealth, happiness to wife and children.
10	Help from rulers, success, realization of just ambitions.
11	Happiness, physical comforts, fame and respectability.
12	Expenditure, enmity with people, illness, disappointments.

- If Muntha occupies a Bhava with malefic aspect or occupation, evil results are intensified.
- If a Bhava has benefic association, aspect or association and is occupied by Muntha, then the vitality of that Bhava is increased.
- If Muntha lord has favorable aspects, then the year as a whole will be favorable.
- If malefics are involved in an unfavorable aspect with the Muntha lord, then the native suffers from ill-health.

Connection Between Muntha and Planets

There are two ways in which Muntha can be connected to a planet:-

- 1) By conjunction or aspect by the planet.
- 2) By lordship of the sign of its occupation.

Association with various planets yields different results (Table II).

If Jupiter aspects the concerned planet, the evil propensity gets greatly reduced.

Varsheswara

Once the analysis on Muntha is over the placement of Varsheswara or year lord needs to Varsheswara are shown in Table III.

Dasa and Bhuktis

The year is sub-divided into a number of periods and each period corresponds to the rulership of a particular planet. For each Dasa, sub-divided periods correspond to Bhuktis. Thus all the nine planets will each contribute to a Bhukti in the Dasa of a planet. While in the Vimshottari Dasa system, the total of all the Dasas comes to 120 years, in the Tajaka system, the total Dasa periods of all the planets adds up to one year only. This facilitates judgment of that year's prospects accurately.

Sahams

Sahams are sensitive points corresponding to events. The numbers of Sahams given by different authors differs with Neclakantha giving 50 Sahams, Venkatesa 48 and Keshava 21 Sahams.

Sahams are arrived at by a process of manipulation of the longitudes of the Ascendant and different planets. The general principle is that if the Sahams and their lords are well associated or aspected, they become conducive to beneficial results.

Comparative Analysis

Given a horoscope, how should the astrologer proceed? Should he choose to follow Parasara and reject the other two? Should he follow all the three and draw broad conclusions? Assuming that the three yield contrary results, which of these should he take as final?

Before an answer can be found to this question an analogy from the dilemmas faced by the medical profession can furnish some clues. Assuming that a patient has diabetes, should medicine be prescribed based on allopathy, homoeopathy, Ayurveda or any of the other alternate systems? Generally, we find that acute diseases are better treated with allopathy, while chronic conditions respond well to alternative systems. Similarly, the methods enunciated by Parasara form the core of

astrology, while the other two are supplementary in nature providing valuable inputs in the hands of a competent astrologer.

There is a Tamil saying, "Even a blade of grass is a powerful weapon in the hands of a good warrior". Thus when it comes to astrological judgment, all inputs must be considered, but while drawing conclusions, factors which are not result-oriented must be set aside and only those planetary indications which are result-producing must be taken into account. Therein lie an astrologer's intelligence and intuition.

The Tajaka system is a vast ocean but in this dissertation, an attempt has been made only to focus on certain core areas of it. A few illustrations will help appreciate the utility of this system.



The native of Chart 1 met with a major accident in August 1990 in Venus Dasa. Venus is the lord of the 12th placed in the 2nd in the birth chart and therefore invested with Maraka powers.

In the Annual chart, we find,

- The lord of the Ascendant is in the 4th afflicted by Rahu.
- The Ascendant has Muntha but is aspected by the malefic 6th lord Jupiter.
- Varsheswara Mars is in a Maraka house in the 2nd afflicted by the Sun.
- The 12th lord and 12th house come under the grip of Saturn. The 12th house governs

Chart 3: Male: Born October 19, 1971 at 15h. 45m. at 22 N 35, 88 E 23.








